We look forward to seeing you on **Thursday 5th at World Book Day, 2:15pm**. If you would like to take your child home afterwards please note this in the home/school book.

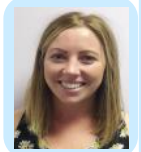

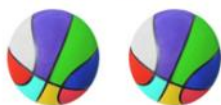
