If this causes a problem with sibling drop offs, please contact us.

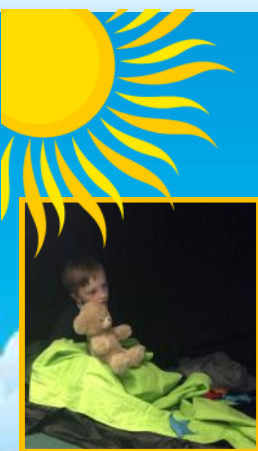
