Our Weekly Music Teaching Offer

Every child receives 1 hour of Music teaching a week in our school - it is a spiral, multi-sensory and well sequenced curriculum designed for Hob Moor needs. All pupils - attend our weekly 30 min music assemblies which includes Listening and Singing.

- **Nursery pupils** - receive a 30 minute music lesson (bespoke Hob Moor curriculum) with listening, chanting, singing and game playing.
- **EYFS - KS1 pupils - Y1 & Y2** - receive a 40-45 min Music lesson with a Music Specialist - bespoke curriculum from Sing education including a range of untuned/tuned percussion plus lots of singing, composing and music games.
- **Y3** - 45 min Music lesson with a Music specialist - bespoke curriculum from Sing education including a range of tuned percussion with a focus on recorders.
- **Y4** - 30 minute lesson (plus music assembly) - recorder is revisited along with tune/untuned percussion.
- **Y5** - 30 minute lesson (plus music assembly) - Children follow a untuned percussion programme with bucket bashing, body percussion and boomwhackers.
- **Y6** - receive a 40-45 min Music lesson with a Music Specialist - bespoke curriculum from Sing education including a range of untuned/tuned percussion plus lots of singing, composing and music games.



Our Music Assemblies

All of our pupils access weekly 30 min music assembly with an additional focus on 'Singing and listening'. Delivered by Sing Education. Children listen to music from a range of genres, time periods and locations all around the world (adapted from the Model Music Curriculum). We use this as time to come together and sing. We also use the time to help our children prepare for our calendar of performances events. SEND - we aim to make our provision accessible to all.

Playing instruments

All of our KS2 children have the opportunity to learn an instrument as a class - recorder, a range of percussion including glockenspiel.

Peri Lessons - we have introduced peri lessons 25/26 with York Music Education. Including guitar, keyboard and drums.

We perform throughout the year in school:

- ★ **Autumn Term:** Carol Concert (Key stage 2) Nativities (EYFS/KS1).
 - ★ **Spring Term:** Young Voices (outside school).
 - ★ **Summer Term:** Class assemblies, Make Music Day - Richard Shepherd Foundation. Leavers Assembly
- Federation Choir:** We also take part in events such as the YiKs concert with the HMO children.



Class Provision includes:
