



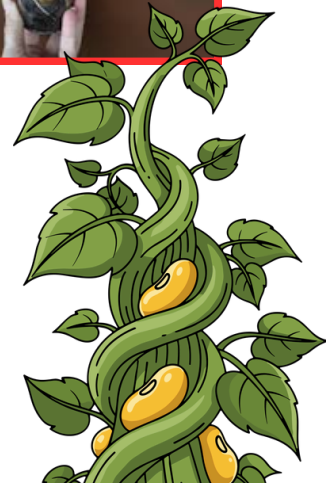
Highlight of the week: EYFS

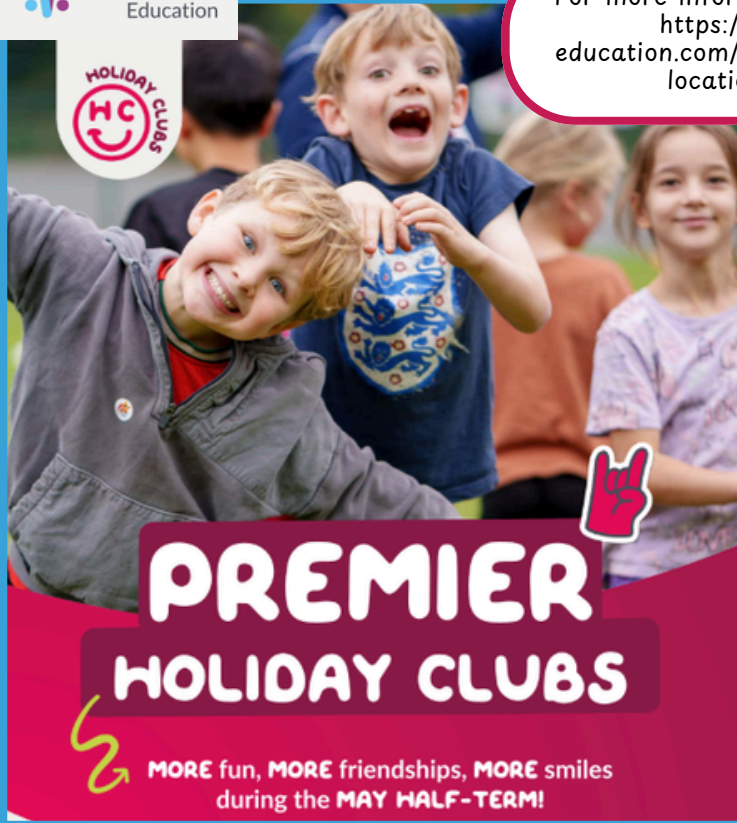
